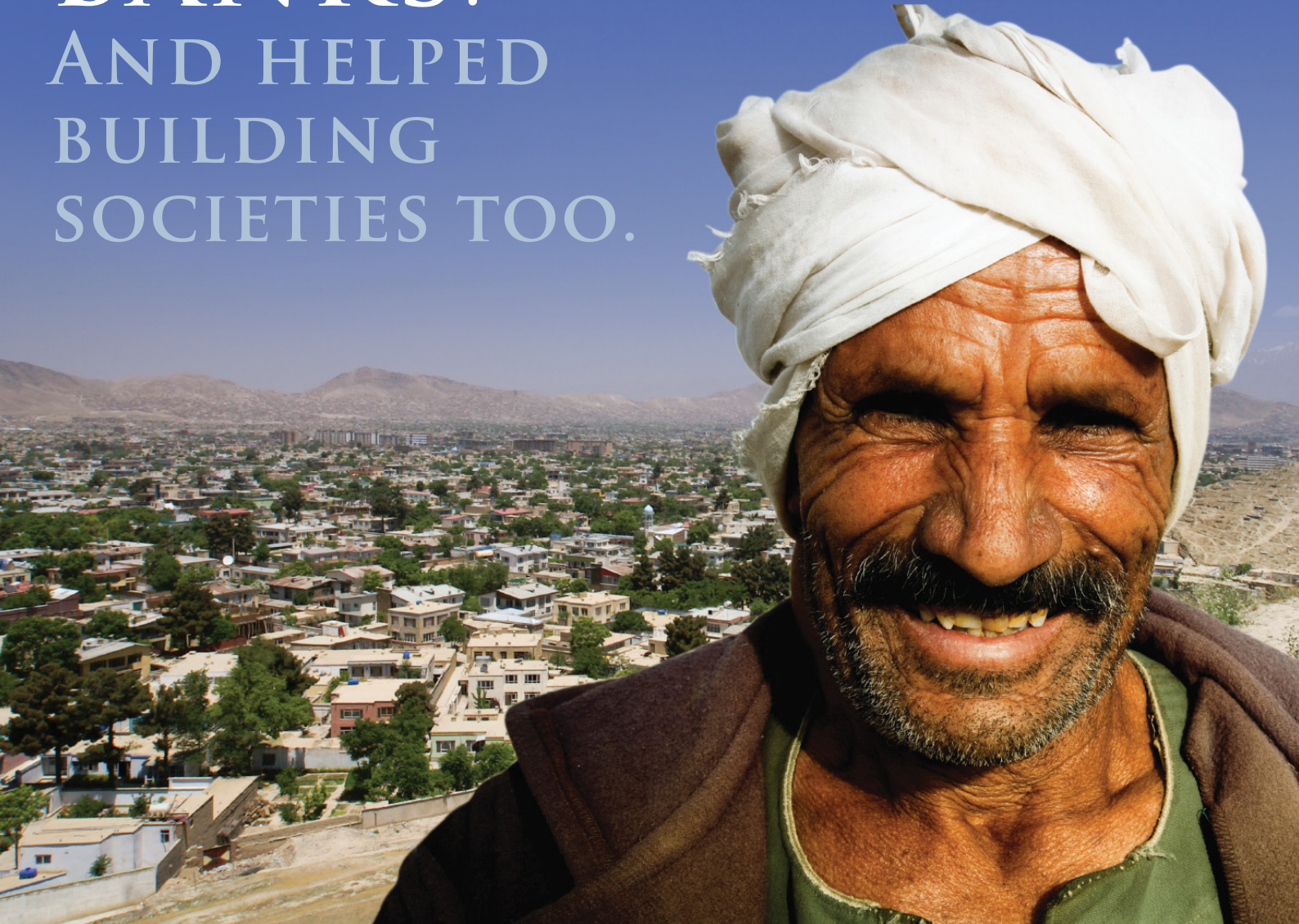


IN BASRA WE RE-OPENED BANKS. AND HELPED BUILDING SOCIETIES TOO.

CASE STUDY: TURN-KEY PROGRAMME, BASRA IRAQ

PROJECT OVERVIEW

In 2003, Oryx Projects designed, created and managed a team of 50 specialists who oversaw the economic management of southern Iraq. The team was responsible for successfully implementing development programmes and reconstruction projects for the Government's multiple ministries.

BUSINESS CHALLENGE

Basra in May 2003 saw national coalition governments who had given little thought to the reconstruction of the Iraqi economy post invasion. From a standing start, with no prior plans a framework for the economic administration was created and implemented.

DELIVERABLES

Facilitate, assist and advise Iraqi government administration

Stand-up government administration across 23 government ministries

Turn-key financial management

Implement international, local and third-country national work groups

SOLUTIONS

MINISTRY OF FINANCE

- The provision of financial administration until Iraqi administration was stood back up
- Full refurbishment of 38 banks

MINISTRY OF MUNICIPALITIES & PUBLIC WORKS

- Removal of 175,000 tonnes of waste from Basra city
- Construct and repair water and sewerage service infrastructure

MINISTRY OF COMMUNICATION

- Introduction of Mobile GSM Telephone Network the first Mobile – GSM system within Iraq
- Introduction of an Emergency Control Centre for Police

MINISTRY OF ELECTRICITY

- Major airport development plans to re-develop existing sites and set up transport links

MINISTRY OF HOUSING & CONSTRUCTION

- Housing project for 500 unit developments
- Road safety improvements and emergency spot repairs

MINISTRY OF EDUCATION

- Co-ordination of 786 school reconstruction and refurbishment projects

MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE

- Implementation of projects to support the agricultural economy
- Road safety improvements and emergency spot repairs

MINISTRY OF HEALTH

- Refurbishment and re-equipping of hospitals
- Training programmes for doctors, nurses and health leaders

MINISTRY OF LABOUR & SOCIAL AFFAIRS

- Alleviate unemployment
- Rehabilitation, re-equipping and reopening of employment centre, social care directorate buildings and welfare payment offices
